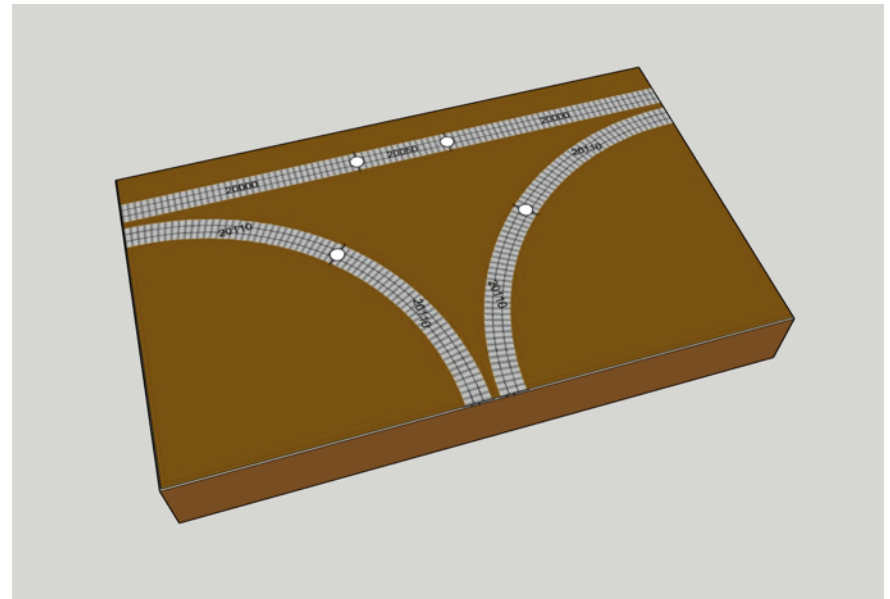
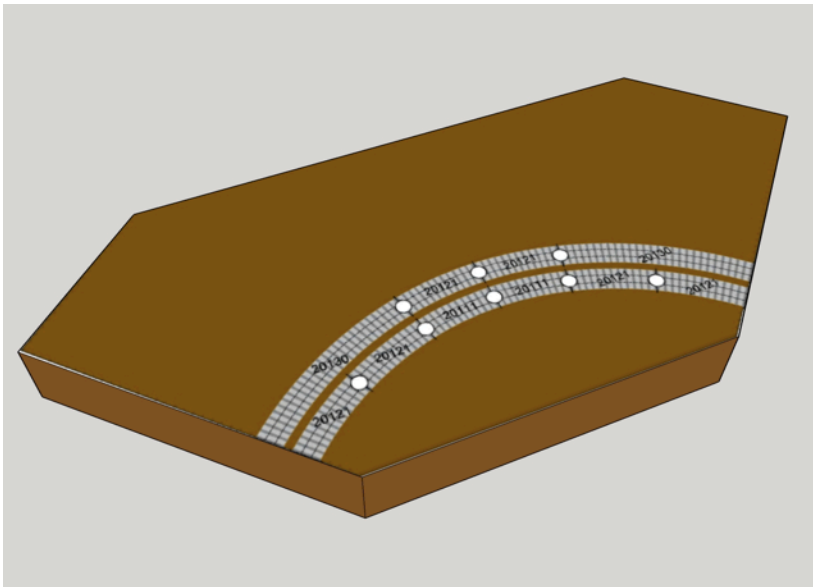
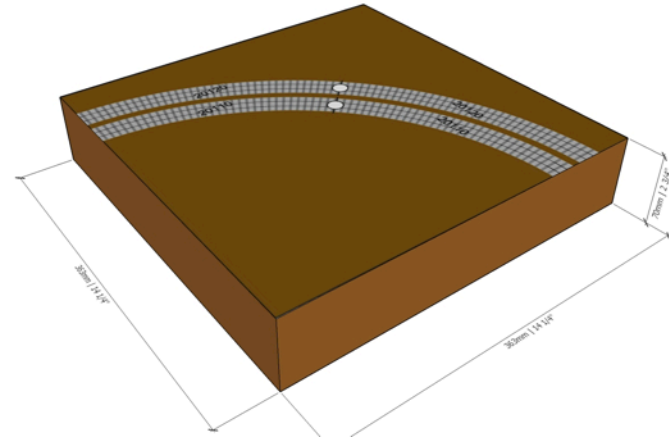
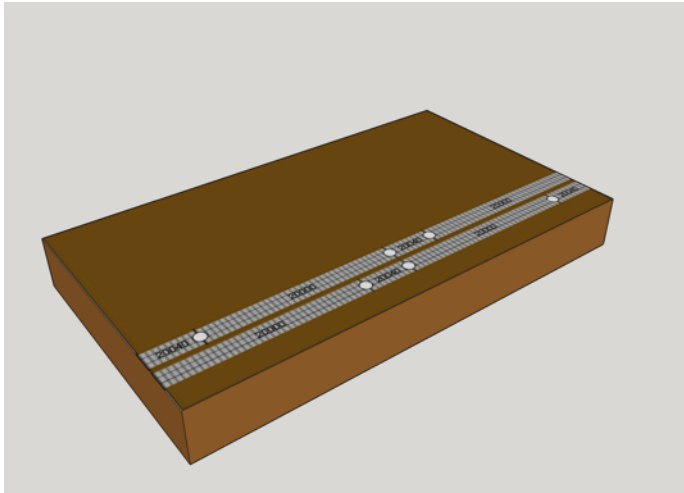
What is T-Trak?

- New approach to modular layouts
- Primarily N-Scale
- Module specification based around Kato Unitrack
- Basic module is small – 12 1/8" x 14"
 - Easy to store
 - Easy to transport
- Flexible size standards allow larger modules
- Snap-together modules
- Designed so that layout can be set up on tables
 - Or floor, or benchwork...
- Electrical interface standards

Standard Basic T-Trak Module

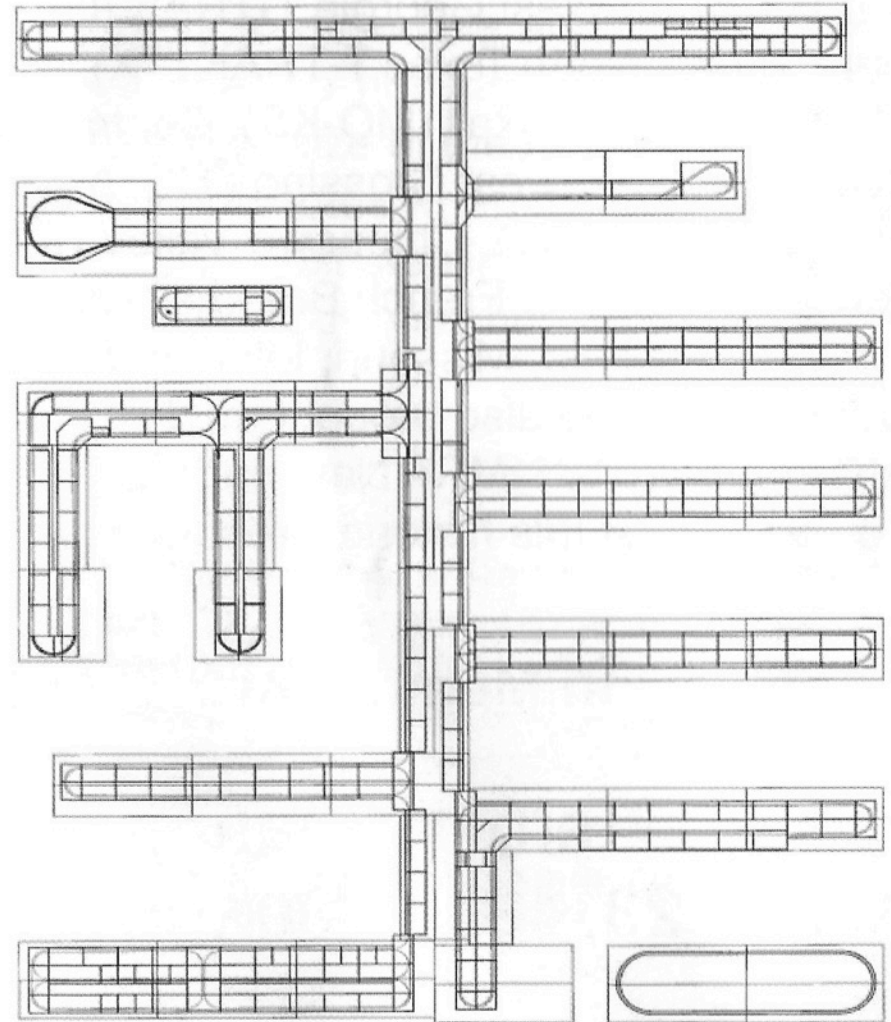


Other standard modules



Kansas City World Record T-Trak Layout

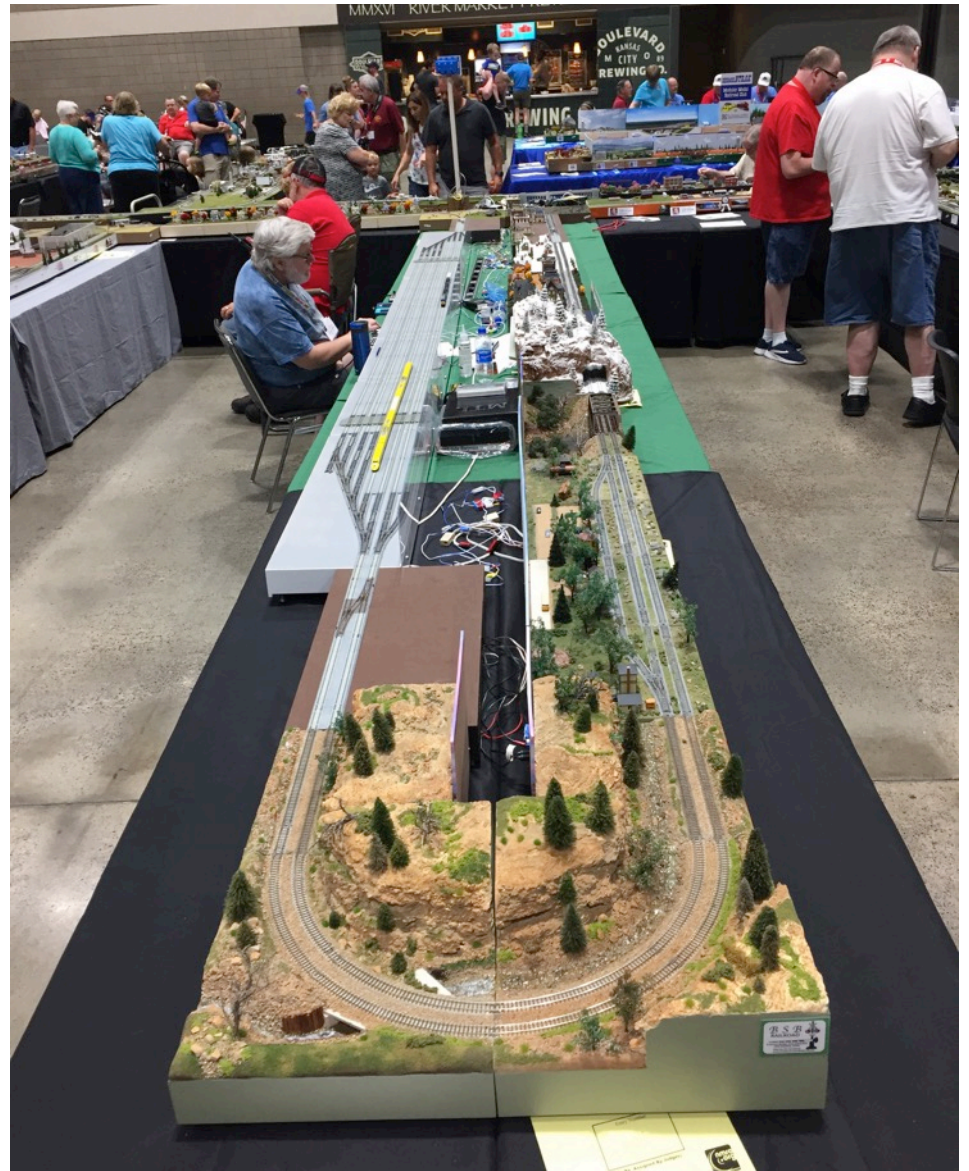
- 330 modules
