

Thanks for reading the Contest News article and before you think that I'm just giving you a snow job, I will sign off so I can go up grease up my snow blower.







The Erie Mad River Model Railroad Club located at 1309 N. Depot Street, Sandusky, Ohio, is having their annual open houses on the following dates:


December 7, 2024, from 12:00 to 4:00 pm, and will feature Steam Locomotives.
